
NZ Defence Force -Submission on the draft copyright Code of Practice for S92A

Dear TCF,

Thank you for a most informative meeting yesterday.

I think it might be helpful if the *Copyright Code of Practice* document, at least once completed, was made available under some license - possibly 'copyleft' or 'creative commons': this is not my area of expertise - which would make it more widely distributable or adaptable without a distributor or adaptor being in danger of a S92A notice from TCF. ;-)

Just a few minor niggles:-

On page 7 of the main document

- ' "Repeat Infringer" ... set out in section D ': the reference should be to Section E, not D
- ' Sworn' ...' should be ' "Sworn" ...' (the opening double quote is missing)

On page 9 of the main document, paragraph 6 needs re-wording

- The header part of the paragraph should read "If a Party" instead of "If a Party receives"
- 6.1 should have the word "receives " inserted at the beginning
- 6.2 should read "receives any Copyright Holder Notice or Counter-Notice that is inadequate or overly complex; or" instead of "if the information in any Copyright Holder Notice or Counter-Notice is inadequate or overly complex; or"
- 6.3 should have the words "if a Party " removed at the beginning

On page 12 of the main document

- 23.2 and 25.2 "it's" should be "its" on the first line: no apostrophe, please.
- 26, third line: ditto

On page 13 of the main document

- 27 change "that that" to "that the" at the end of the first line
- Move the words "the user has at least" from the end of 27 to the beginning of 27.1
- 27.2 change "with each of those being in" to "each of those are"
- 27.3 change "being" to "are"
- 29 the last portion " (but may ... Provider)." does not appear to need the parentheses

On page 17 of the main document

- 54 I think change "Internet Service Provider" to "Party" on the second line

On page 18 of the main document

- 58 I think change "ISP" to "Party" on the second line
- 59 I think change "ISP's" to "Party's" on the first line

On page 4 of the supplemental document

- 28.2 and 30.2 "it's" should be "its" on the first line: no apostrophe, please.
- 31, third line: ditto
